





COMPETITON COVID-19 PROTOCOL



- 1) Obligatory use of the mask at all times, even when it is possible to keep a minimum distance of 1.5 metres.
- 2) Soap and water, alcohol gels and other anti-virus cleaning products will be available at all times for staff, participants and the audience.
- 3) Showers and WCs at the football ground will be cleaned regularly.
- 4) Organizational measures will be taken to avoid large crowds or gatherings of people
- 5) Informative posters will be available in all the different areas of the football ground.

1) The organizing staff will give a free commemorative mask to each person competing in the event, as well as a plastic zip bag where they can store the

mask before entering to compete.



2) There will be bottles of alcohol gel to wash hands and the entrance to the venue, in each WC, at the entrance and exit of each ring and at various points throughout the football ground. It is requested that they are not removed from their places. Furthermore, each ring will have a bottle of cleaning fluid (70% alcohol) in case any surfaces require cleaning.

3) There will be reinforced cleaning measures throughout the 5 days of the competition to ensure that maximum hygiene in the WCs and showers is achieved. We expect full collaboration of all attendees in ensuring that these remain in perfect conditions throughout the competition.




4) The organizing staff will adopt different measures to ensure that crowds are avoided.






4.2) For the prize-giving for each Grade, Open and the Grand Final, only the three qualifying participants, the judge and one person from the organizing team will be able to enter the podium, all wearing masks and while keeping the maximum distance possible between themselves. All podium photographs will be taken by the organizing team and will be uploaded to the RIALP Facebook page and web side where it will be possible to download them.



4.3) The recognition of the course must be done wearing a mask. The entry and exit of the group taking part in the recognition of the course will be done in a staged manner, individually. It is not permitted to touch the obstacles during the recognition. In the pre-ring of the competition, 2m of distance must be maintained between participants while they are waiting to enter the course and it is obligatory to wear the mask. On entering, the mask can be removed and stored in the plastic zip bag and left in the container that will be available in the entrance. Once the participant begins the course, the container with the mask, lead and toys will be left in the exit where the competitor will be able to collect them upon finishing the course. It will be not be permitted to complete the recognition of the course or compete without shoes on.






4.4) In order to avoid participants coinciding, there will be different routes established for each grade and category to get to their corresponding pre-ring.



The competitors for G2 and G3 that compete in RING 1 will enter and exit via the central area and those participating in RING 2 via the side closest to the warm-up area. It will be obligatory for participants in G1 will enter and exit via the side. Participants for PRE-AGILITY will enter via the side closest to the road.

4.5) Participants will not hand in passes to the control table. The labels with the daily qualifications signed by the judge will be placed in an envelope with the Grade, corresponding day and the name of the club and will be collected by one representative of each club and the handed out to each participant to add to their qualification pass.





- 4.6) All participants must pass through the veterinary tent to carry out the control of the microchip and vaccines. Guides must wear their masks and take with them their veterinary pass so that the vet, Alicia Robles, can review them. In the case of queues, an obligatory distance of 1.5m must be maintained. Hands must be washed with alcohol gel once the veterinary revision has been completed.
- 5) An informative poster will be put up in different areas of the football ground with the aim of keeping all participants and audience members (in the case that they can enter) informed of the basic rules that must be followed in order to prevent the spread of COVID-19 and ensure that the competition is 100% safe.
